Here is an outline of the home learning activities for the Reception classes this half term. Your child can choose to complete one of these activities each week. Please sign the grid to show that your child has done an activity and send in the Learning Grid every Tuesday with any form of recording your child has done (e.g. photo, picture, 'writing', children's quotes, or creations).



Choose one of these activities to complete each week.

Short Stories

Write a short story to read to the class. How will you begin your story? What will happen to your characters? How will your story end?



Extension: Describe your characters. What do they look like? How do they act?

Doubling

Take one object from your home then double it. How many do you have? Then try doubling two objects... three... all the way to ten.



Extension: Have a go at doubling numbers/objects to 20.

Summer Holidays

Soon it will be the Summer Holidays. Use the attached suitcase to draw everything you will need. If you are going somewhere, will it be hot or cold? Or where would you like to go?



Extension: Label the items in your suitcase.

Counting in 2s, 5s 10s

Start at 0 and count in 2s, then 5s then 10s.
How high can you count? Can you start from
a different number? e.g. 6,8,10,12

2 × 0	=	0
2 × 1	=	2
2 × 2	=	4
2 × 3	=	6
2 × 4	=	8
2 × 5	=	10
2 × 6	=	12

Extension: Can you learn your 2 times table?

Weekly Home Learning:

Phonics

Using your child's sound book, practise any
new sounds for the week as well as
recapping previously learned sounds.
When your child can recognise them
confidently get them to write them when
you say the sound.

Ext: Focus on a particular sound and create
a word list for that sound.

Reading books

Please try to read your child's reading book
with them twice a week. Don't forget to
write a comment in the reading record so
that we can make sure new reading books
are given out frequently.

Ext: If your child particularly enjoys a book,
have a go at completing a simple book
review with them. There are some at the
back of their reading record.

Teddy words

Practise your child's teddy words. It is also
beneficial to recap previous teddy words
regularly.

Ext: Have a go at writing some of your
teddy words.
