



Home Learning Grid: Nursery Spring 1 2018



Here is an outline of the home learning activities for the Nursery children, this half term, on our topic 'In the toy box.' Your child may choose to complete one of these activities each week.

Please sign the grid to show that your child has done an activity and send in the Learning Grid every **Tuesday**. If any form of recording has been done by your child please bring it in and this can be added to their Learning Journal e.g. photo, picture, 'writing', children's quotes, or creations.

Talk about a favourite toy

Choose your favourite toy and speak to an adult about it. For example: 'It is a _____. I like it because ____.' Then you can tell your Nursery friends about your favourite toy.



Extension: Draw a picture or take a photo of your toy, write down your toy's name (you could use letters cut out from a newspaper or try writing them).

Shopping Lists

Help mummy or daddy make a shopping list and see if you can find the items on it. You could draw the items or find pictures of them to create your list.



Extension: Say each item on your list. What sound can you hear at the beginning of the word? Try to write the first sound.

Make a puppet

Try making a puppet. It could be a lolly stick puppet, a finger puppet or a sock puppet. Use your imagination to create an interesting puppet.



Extension: Can you put on a puppet show using your creation?

How many plates on your table?
How many teddies in your bed?
How many people in your home?
Lots of things to count!



Extension: Have a go at showing these numbers on your fingers, marks on paper or even trying to write the number.

Select 3 or 4 of your toys. Which one is the biggest/smallest? Could you place them in size order? (Smallest to biggest / biggest to smallest)



Extension: Represent this by cutting out toy pictures and sticking in order, photos or drawings.

Walk in your local area or to the park. What signs of Winter can you find? For example: colours, animals, weather, types of clothes worn etc...



Extension: Find a story that is set in Winter. What signs show it is Winter? Look at the pictures.
