Here is an outline of the home learning activities for the Nursery children, this half term. You may choose to complete one of these activities each week.

## Alliteration Animals

We have been talking about rhyming words and are now focusing on alliteration in Nursery. What animal starts with the same sound as your name? For example Harry Hen, Susan Snake.

How many wild animals can you think of? Think of names that would start with the same sound. E.g. L..... Lion, C..... Camel.

## Musical Fun

'Old Macdonald had a farm E, I, E, I, O...'  
This song has many verses about the different farm animals and the noises they make. Make your own musical instrument to play to this song.



Ext. Use your instrument to make up your own rhythm. Think about loud/quiet sounds and playing fast/slow.

Have a look in newspapers and magazines for numbers. Make your own number line from 0-10 with the numbers you find. You may even find numbers outside that you could use if you take a photo.



Ext: Have a look for 'teen' numbers 11 – 20.

What is your favourite animal? Find out about the animal. You could look in an information book or on the internet. Draw a picture and have a go at writing its name.



Ext: Tell an interesting fact about the animal.
