Here is an outline of the home learning activities for the Reception classes this half term. Your child can choose to complete one of these activities each week. Please sign the grid to show that your child has done an activity and send in the Learning Grid every Tuesday with any form of recording your child has done (e.g. photo, picture, 'writing', children's quotes, or creations).



Choose one of these activities to complete each week.

Writing sentences

Design your own dinosaur. What does it eat?
What does it look like? What colour is it?
What does it like to do all day?



Extension: Answer the same questions about your favourite dinosaur? Where can you find this dinosaur information?

Number hunt

Go on a number hunt for 2 digit numbers!
Can you spot any road signs with numbers on them?



Extension: Think of the number that is one more or one less than the number you spotted.

Jungle explorer

What do you need to be a jungle explorer?
Can you make your own binoculars or magnifying glass to spot all the animals in the jungle? Write a list of words to describe the animals you see!

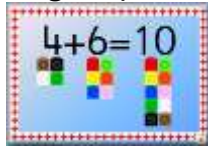


Extension: Find a non-fiction book about your favourite jungle animal. What interesting information can you find?

Making 10

Find 5/10 objects, e.g. bottle tops/lids, marbles, counters, action figures etc.... How many ways can you separate them into two groups?



Extension: Repeat the activity, selecting a different number, up to 20.

Can you order the following words alphabetically? Remember to sing the alphabet song to help you order them.

- bee
- dog
- cat
- ant

Extension: Think of as many animals as possible and order them alphabetically.

Weekly Home Learning:

Phonics

Using your child's sound book, practise any new sounds for the week as well as recapping previously learned sounds.

When your child can recognise them confidently get them to write them when you say the sound.

Ext: Focus on a particular sound and create a word list for that sound.

Reading books

Please try to read your child's reading book with them twice a week. Don't forget to write a comment in the reading record so that we can make sure new reading books are given out regularly.

Ext: If your child particularly enjoys a book, have a go at completing a simple book review with them. There are some sheets at the back of their reading record.

Teddy words

Practise your child's teddy words. It is also beneficial to recap previous teddy words regularly.

Ext: Have a go at writing some of your teddy words.
