



Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing on behalf of the School, Residents, Local Councillors and Hertfordshire police.

Over the past year we have had concerns raised to us regarding parents/guardians parking and speeding in the locality of Highwood School in Mead Way and Bushey Mill Lane, Bushey.

The majority of these complaints have centred on vehicles being parked in obstructive, inconsiderate and in some cases dangerous positions.

It is appreciated by all parties mentioned above, that parents need to collect their children with as little delay as possible due to various time constraints. So please leave enough time to allow walking from a point further away from the school if there is no suitable parking near the school entrance. **Do not** park on the junctions, double yellow lines, zigzag lines, grass verges or over residents' driveways.

Please have consideration for others during these times, especially for the safety of the children, pedestrians, the local residents, and other road users.

Regular patrols will be conducted during the term and if appropriate, a Fixed Penalty Notice (£30.00 fine) will be issued to anyone causing an unnecessary obstruction or the appropriate action will be taken if any other offences are identified.

The majority of road users are mindful and considerate of others and this is sent as a reminder that parents/guardians/carers collecting or dropping off need to be mindful of others even when there are other pressures or time constraints.
