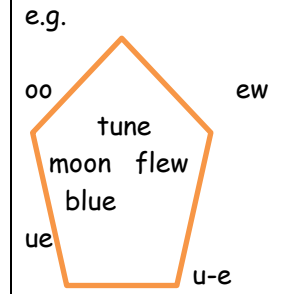
We are learning the value of each coin and how to add to find a total amount.
