Use your knowledge from Literacy lessons and the school trip to help you.</p> <p><u>Extension:</u> Act it out with a friend. What objects does your magnet attract and which does it not? Create a table to show your findings – include a prediction column – do you think it will be magnetic?</p> <p>What is similar about the magnetic materials? <p><u>Maths (wb 12.06.17)</u> Use trial and improvement to find a solution. Show all your attempts even if they don't work. Is there more than one solution?</p> <p style="margin-left: 20px;">Kieran has three cats. Use your experience of Year 3 to create a leaflet for the current Year 2s to tell them what Year 3 is all about. You can explain some of the topics we have covered, and games they might like to play with their friends now they're in KS2. Using the work we have done on description, and your knowledge from our Roman Topic and create a character that could be in your story. You need to include description regarding their appearance (remember when in history they are from) and their personality. Use adjectives, alliteration, similes, metaphors and detailed sentences using conjunctions.</p> <p><u>Extension:</u> Draw a picture of your character to go with the profile.</p> <p>Parent/Carer signature.....</p>
<p><u>History (wb 26.06.17)</u> The children will be studying daily life in Ancient Rome, the creation of the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.
