






The inspection report identifies "widespread and/or systemic failings" across the local area partnership led by Hertfordshire County Council and the NHS Hertfordshire and West Essex Integrated Care Board (ICB). It is the lowest rating possible. This means that the inspection identified failings that have a "significant, negative impact on the experiences and outcomes of children and young people".
