Here is an outline of the home learning activities for the Reception children, this half term. You may choose to complete one of these activities each week. **Please sign the Home Learning grid** to show that the activity has been completed and **send it in every Tuesday**. If any form of recording has been done by your child, please bring it in and this can be added to their Learning Journal or a display. For example, a photo, picture, 'writing', children's quotes or creations.

Lifecycles

Look at photos of yourself and discuss how you have changed over time and how you have stayed the same. If you can, bring in some of the photos ready to share with the class. Create a timeline using photos, if possible, to show how you have changed/stayed the same.



Extension: Label your timeline with how old you were.

Plants

Make a poster about what a plant needs to grow.



Extension: Can you write a sentence about what your plant needs? Or grow your own plant from a seed?

Odd or Even

Collect a set of objects from around your home. Share them out between yourself and someone else. Do you have an equal amount? If you do, you have an even number of objects. If you have an unequal amount, you have an odd number. How could you make it even?



Extension: Can you write a number sentence to show what you did?

Observational drawings

Find a tree, plant or animal, look at it and draw exactly what you can see. Think about the different colours used.



Extension: Can you label your picture with the media and colours you have used.

Write some instructions on how to do something. This could be anything, e.g. how to wash your hands, brush your teeth, how to bake something or how to plant a seed.
