



## Geography - Europe

The children will be taught key knowledge and skills to help them answer our Big Question:

### Where are the European cities and why are they located where they are?



They will look at primary and secondary sources to help them locate European cities. The children will use their knowledge of biomes to describe climates in Europe.

## Black History Month



Black History Month (which will be taking place in October) is also a focus in our school and, in both assemblies and lessons, children will be researching and learning about figures from black history who have contributed to our world and who have much to teach us about resilience and respect.

## Art

We will be learning about the artist Gustav Klimt. During this half term, we will be sketching facial features from first-hand observations to create a self-portrait.

We will practise different colour combinations and use of pastels to mark make.



PE

In our PE lessons we will be learning the following key skills when participating in a variety of activities:  
Children will learn to persevere with a task and improve their performance through regular practice, reacting positively when things become difficult. They will begin to challenge themselves and know where they are with their learning.  
We will learn to develop our resilience by practising our skills and by asking for help when appropriate.  
We will also be taking part in the Joy of Moving initiative provided by Watford Football Club.



RE

The children will be learning about Christianity, Hinduism and Sikhism this year. This half term they will be exploring what it means to live as a Hindu and how and where Hindus worship to help answer our Big Question:

### Why does worship play a significant part in a Hindu's life?

## P.S.H.E- 'Being me in my world'



This half term, the children will explore the rights and responsibilities that come with being a citizen. They will discuss the importance of democracy, relating this practically to our School Council.

The children will think about how they can use their own voice positively, whilst also participating in group decision making.

## Computing



We will be learning about data handling and online/electronic data collection and then use the skills to create our own questionnaires to solve a given synopsis. We will also be finding out about the computing Pioneer Alan Turing.  
As part of our E-safety learning we will be focussing on what personal information we can and shouldn't share online and cyberbullying.

## Music



This half term we will be exploring gospel music through the song *This Little Light of Mine*, which is based around the pentatonic scale. We will learn the song, a simple bassline accompaniment and create a rhythmic ostinato and pentatonic improvisations, to produce the classes' own arrangement of the song.

## French



The children will learn the names for some sports and some food and drinks associated with healthy lifestyles. They will revise the days of the week, learn to say what activities they do on particular days and ask and answer questions about a diary.
